If your address has changed within the district, you will need to bring approved documentation to our Enrollment Office for verification. As in the past, we will not accept bus pass requests unless an emergency arises validated by the building principal.
- Attendance is critical to your child's academic success. Uninterrupted instructional time is important for all students. We do not encourage student late entries or early dismissals although we understand that doctor, dentist, and orthodontist schedules can conflict with the school day. If you must schedule these appointments during school hours we ask that you bring signed documentation verifying your visit so your child's attendance record can be adjusted accordingly. Please make note of the important test dates below to avoid conflicts with vacations and/or appointments.
- A School Planner will be provided for all middle school students. Enclosed in the Planner is the Student Handbook and is available on the middle school webpage for reference. We encourage you to read your Student Handbook as a few changes have been made. Please sign the signature page in the Student Handbook and return it to their homeroom teacher no later than Friday, September 10.
