

FALL CLEAN UP FAQ

- What does the Fall Clean Up cost?
 - There is NO CHARGE for the Fall Clean Up. The cost is being paid from the \$1 charge on your electric bill.
- Do we have to come to the electric office to buy a ticket?
 - No. Your ticket will be included in your October electric bill. Please be sure to secure your ticket as soon as you receive your bill, as no replacements will be available.
- What if I receive my bill electronically?
 - Your flier with attached ticket will be mailed to you.
- Is there any curb side pickup being offered?
 - No. We are not able to offer any curb side pickup for this clean up.
- Will there be a curbside pickup in the future?
 - Stay tuned for information on a curb side pickup in the Spring of 2027! A curbside pickup will involve strategic planning with Aiken Refuse. More details will be posted when the pickup is planned!
- Will there be anyone to help unload our items?
 - Yes! Borough workers will be available to assist you in unloading your items into the dumpsters.
- How much am I allowed to dispose?
 - Each ticket allows for ONE Pickup truck or ONE passenger car load of items. No trailers allowed.
- Are extra tickets available?
 - No. There are no extra tickets available. In order for all residents to drop their items for disposal, we have to limit the amount of items accepted from each resident.
- What if I am not going to use my ticket?
 - There is nothing you have to do. You may dispose of your ticket.
- Do I need to sign up anywhere?
 - No, there is no need for sign up. Simply bring your ticket to the dump site on October 10th or October 17th with your items to dispose. The crew will take your ticket and assist with unloading your items in the dumpster.
- What are the dates and times again?
 - Saturday, October 10th and Saturday, October 17th from 8am-4pm at 1210 Factory Avenue.
